

Rabun County Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax

(Vote for One)

* Shall a one percent special purpose local option sales and use tax be continued in the special district of Rabun County for a period of time of six years and for the raising of an estimated amount of \$20,000,000 for the purpose of (1) funding water and sewer improvements, parks and recreation improvements, including a golf course, solid waste management infrastructure, a senior center, roads, streets and bridges and fire protection in Rabun County; (2) funding water and sewer improvements, fiber optic infrastructure, roads and streets, and City Hall improvements in the City of Dillard; (3) funding roads in the City of Sky Valley; (4) funding roads, streets and bridges and public safety improvements in the City of Mountain City; (5) funding roads, streets and bridges, parks and recreation, a municipal maintenance building and water and sewer improvements in the City of Tiger; and (6) funding water improvements, roads, bridges and trails and public safety improvements in the City of Tallulah Falls? If imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of the general obligation debt of Rabun County in the principal amount of not to exceed \$9,100,000 for the purpose of funding all or a portion of the County projects.*
